THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

Joint case management

1. This proceeding (**New Proceeding**) be case managed together with the proceeding numbered NSD1210/2019 (**Existing Proceeding**) (together, the **Toyota DPF Proceedings**).
2. The parties are permitted to use information and documents obtained in either of the Toyota DPF Proceedings for the purposes of the other Toyota DPF Proceeding.
3. Evidence filed in each Toyota DPF Proceedings is to be treated as evidence in the other Toyota DPF Proceeding.

Pleadings

4. By 19 September 2025, the respondent is to file and serve its defence.
5. By 3 October 2025, the applicant is to file and serve any reply.

Discovery

6. By 26 September 2025, the parties are to give discovery under r 20.14 of *the Federal Court Rules 2011* (Cth) of documents that are directly relevant to the applicant's acquisition and ownership of his Relevant Vehicle.



Evidence

7. By 17 October 2025, the applicant is to file and serve any evidence in chief in relation to the applicant's acquisition and ownership of his Relevant Vehicle on which he proposes to rely at the initial trial (but noting that such evidence will not address the quantification of any damages).
8. By 5 December 2025, the respondent is to file and serve any evidence in relation to the applicant's acquisition and ownership of their Relevant Vehicle on which the respondent proposes to rely at the initial trial (but noting that such evidence will not address the quantification of any damages).

Case management

9. The matter be listed for a case management hearing at 9:30am on 19 December 2025.

Initial trial

10. Subject to further order, the matter is available to be listed for the initial trial commencing on 19 October 2026 for a period of 2 weeks.
